The American Center of Oriental Research (ACOR) in Amman, Jordan is a private, international, non-profit academic institution dedicated to promoting research and publication in the fields of archaeology, anthropology, history, languages, Islam, and other aspects of Near Eastern studies.

Since it was founded in 1968, ACOR has implemented restoration and excavation projects throughout the Kingdom. The center is located near the University of Jordan and contains a major library for researchers in Jordan. Almost six hundred fellowships have been awarded by ACOR during the period from 1971 to 2008

The ACOR publication program has published ten books including *The Mosaics of Jordan* (1992), *Madaba: Cultural Heritage* (1996), *The Petra Church* (2001), *Petra Papyri I* (2002) and III (2007). *Megalithic Jordan* represents the launch of a new series that will present different aspects of Jordan's fascinating heritage, aimed at a broader audience.
